### October 20 Business Meeting Minutes

Location: Sea Turtle Inn, Jacksonville—Attendance: 23

Meeting called to order by President, Chris Fulmer, at 12:27 p.m.

Chris Fulmer welcomed all Board of Directors and guests. Introductions were made.

**Invocation** – Laura Dana (absent): Chris Fulmer announced that Laura Dana is currently taking her nursing clinical exams, and is unable to attend convention. In Laura's absence, Becky Ritchie read a poem that was printed in Twins Magazine in 2001 titled, "Half of My Heart" by Jennifer Seams.

**Secretary** – Becky Ritchie: Becky asked for corrections to the Board of Directors roster and for corrections to the July 15<sup>th</sup> board meeting minutes.

**MOTION: Adrienne Austin moved to approve the minutes as printed in the newsletter. Jana Werksman seconded the motion. Motion passed.**

**1<sup>st</sup> VP Membership** – Tina Jenicek: Tina reported that the FOMOTC ended the year as of 9/1/06 with **22** member clubs with a total of **1,028** members.

Tina announced the VIP clubs as follows: Coral Springs MoMs, FL Keys MoMs, Greater Deland, Greater Orlando MoTT, JACK-POTTs, Lakeland\*, Pinellas PoDs, Sarasota, South Dade, and Space-coast. \*Lakeland club rejoined after a several year absence. Tina reported that 20 out of 22 clubs will

have a Light in Shining Armor recipient this year.

The current membership roster only reflects 2005-06 membership rosters and board members. Clubs' 2006-07 board members and membership totals will be reflected in the membership roster come January.

**2<sup>nd</sup> VP Research** – Adrienne Austin: Adrienne announced that today is "Carmel Apple Day". She stated different facts pertaining to women. Since 55% of women color their hair, Adrienne asked attendees to state how old were they when they first started to color their hair.

The FOMOTC's Power Point presentation, "What does the FOMOTC do for local clubs?" is completed and Adrienne will present her 6 min. presentation to the convention delegation during the general session. A script is available. Board members will be asked to travel to different state affiliated clubs to present the power point presentation.

**Treasurer** – Linda Cairns: Linda handed out the proposed budget for the 2006-07 year. Terri Gillis reported that the price of the LISA plaques will be increased 10% in 2006-07.

Jana Werksman suggested the 2 free convention registrations be transferable. Deb Knox, 2006 pre-registration recipient, was unable to attend this year's convention.

**MOTION: Terri Gillis moved that the 2007 pre-registrations be**

**transferable within the same year. Anne Seufert seconded the motion. Motion passed with no abstentions.**

Marla Wagler asked why is the treasurer's budget is only \$10. Linda informed the board that in the past, the Treasurer donated all of their expenses. Marla Wagler suggested that the budget be increased. Chris Fulmer suggested that the proposed budget be amended to reflect changes to the convention expenses and treasurer's budget. The convention expenses line item will be reduced \$600 and the Treasurer's budget will be increased to \$50. **MOTION: Adrienne Austin moved to accept the budget as amended. Kathy Belmonte seconded the motion. Motion passed with no abstentions.**

Convention announcements – Locations for the workshops have been changed. Due to renovations to the pool area, any attendees that requested an Oceanfront room will receive a reduced room rate and a complimentary chair and umbrella on the beach. Nery announced that the convention committee was only informed of the pool renovation a few weeks ago. Nery reported that 5 out of 123 registered attendees have requested refunds. Convention chairs did not anticipate the low turn out. Convention sponsors have helped a great deal with expenses. Hotel has been fabulous and easy to work with. Terri expressed a "Job Well Done."

Marlene reported that the hotel name has changed to the Key Largo Grande Resort and Beach Club. The hotel will honor our contract and Marlene will check to see if they will honor Sheraton's Reward Point System. Food tasting meeting will be scheduled sometime in Dec./Jan. Convention flyers reflecting the hotel name change will be mailed out to state clubs.

#### Convention 2008 –

**Cruise Proposal:** Tina Jenicek/Becky Ritchie—Linda reported the cruise proposal will be presented to the convention delegation. At the request of several board members, a ballot vote will be conducted. Linda reported that if the cruise proposal is denied, another club has stepped up to host Discussion ensued regarding why this club wants to remain anonymous. It was announced that Greater Orlando MOTT was the club that volunteered. Chris suggested that the cruise proposal be presented as is, and if a member asks if there are any other bids, the back-up bid would be announced.

#### Historian – Chiquitta Nash:

(absent) Chris Fulmer read an email from Chiquitta stating that she was unable to attend convention due to personal and financial reasons. Chiquitta sent the scrapbooks with fellow T-PoTS member, Kim Buechner.

#### Newsletter Editor & Publisher –

Tracy Fischer: (absent) - Chris reported that Tracy will be attending convention and the newsletter dead-

line is December 1<sup>st</sup>. Please adhere to the newsletter deadline. If you send an email to Tracy and you do not receive a “thank you” response, she did not receive it.

**Newsletter Reporter** – Tina Jenicek: - Tina reported she will continue to submit a Club Spotlight article next year.

**Ways & Means** – Kim Buechner: (absent) No report

**Publicity** – Karen Art: - Karen reported that the St. Pete Parents of Twins and Triplets was the only club that submitted a copy of their newsletter for the Newsletter Contest. Jana stated that Coral Springs sent Karen three issues of their newsletter. Jana gave Karen a duplicate copy of their newsletter. St. Pete's and Coral Springs' newsletters will be on display and convention attendees will vote for their favorite. The winner will be announced at the General Session meeting. The winner will receive a prize.

**Website** – Robin McCarty: - Robin reported that she experienced no major problems this year with the website. She stated that she plans to implement a zip code function similar to National's website.

**Nominating Chair** – Kathy Belmonte: - Kathy read a letter from FOMOTC chaplain Laura Dana which stated her reasons for her absence from this year's convention and her request for the board to accept her nomination for chaplain for 2006-07 year.

**MOTION:** Adrienne Austin moved that Standing rule; FO-MOTC Conventions #4 Nominations and elections. d., which applies to a nominee's attendance at convention to be eligible for election, be suspended for one year. Jana Werskman seconded the motion. Motion passed with no abstentions.

Kathy announced the slate for the 2006-07 year. Kathy reported that 2 board members, Tracy Fischer and Kim Buechner, are running for positions that they have already held for 2 years.

**MOTION:** Adrienne Austin moved that the bylaw rule, Article IV, Section 1.A.2, which applies to the eligibility of an elected officer to serve more than 2 consecutive terms in the same office, be suspended for one year. Linda Yaffee seconded the motion. Motion passed.

**Credentials** – Dedi Ahmay: - Dedi reported that some clubs have not submitted their credentials. She will have a Credentials table set up next to registration.

**Scholarship Chair** – Sandy Davis: - Sandy reported that she received 4 applications this year. The scholarship committee decided to awarded scholarships to all 4 applicants. Sandy asked that we need to urge clubs to encourage their members to apply to the scholarship program. Committee will make revisions to the criteria and application in the next year. Revisions will take effect in 2007-2008 year. Sandy reported that the scholarship committee will remain the same for next year.

**Parliamentarian** – Sheila Brennan: (absent) - Chris announced that due to personal reasons, Sheila would not be able to attend today's meeting. She hopes to arrive in time for Saturday morning's general session meeting.

**NOMOTC Convention** – Terri Gillis: - Terri reported that the FOMOTC received a 4.51 rating out of 5.0 on the NOMOTC convention surveys, which is excellent. Due to circumstances with the convention hotel, dates for the 2007 convention in San Diego have changed to July 29<sup>th</sup> – August 4<sup>th</sup>, 2007. Terri recognized all the FOMOTC national workers for the 2006-07 year.

Chris announced corrections to the convention booklet. Sarasota's membership total was incorrect. It was changed to read 57 members. The total number of members was changed to read 1,028. ### Tracy Fischer—Newsletter Editor/Publisher

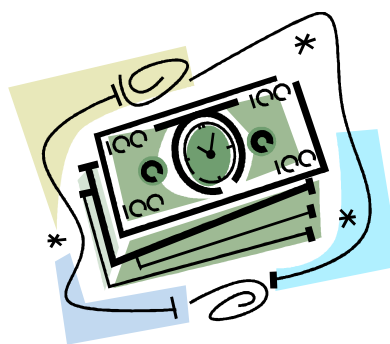

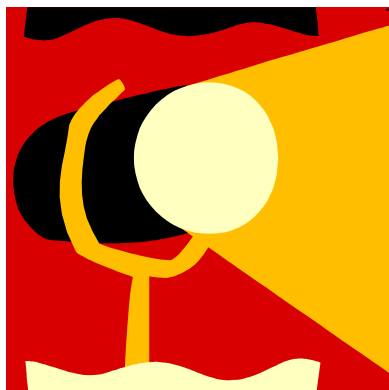
## Credentials Report by Dedi Ahmay

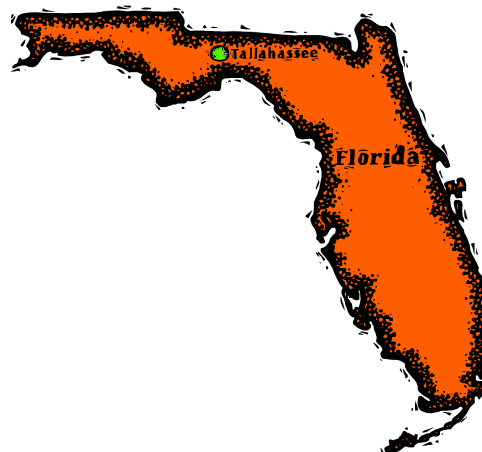
